You are so valuable to God that He was willing to pay the ultimate price, sending His Son Jesus to die in your place. He gave up everything that He had because you were worth it.

Now imagine this—a field with hundreds of thousands of people, all whose souls are worth that ultimate price Jesus paid, hearing the infallible Word of God. Upon hearing the Gospel preached, they have the choice to accept Jesus, stepping over into eternal life. No longer are their souls hanging in the balance, no longer do they face the enemy’s threat of dying for eternity. Their eternity begins in that “180° moment,” the turning point in the right direction towards God. Now they can truly live.

This summer, we will take part in this transformation, both home and abroad. In July, a team of on-fire youth from our Solid Rock Youth group, along with dedicated adults will head down to Biloxi, Mississippi to bring hope to this hurricane ravished area. Biloxi is a town of diverse culture and history, laced with French influences. Its

location on the Gulf Coast has made it a popular vacation spot for centuries. Biloxi was one of the most devastated communities by Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Businesses were destroyed, homes flattened, lives lost; destruction walked the streets leaving its rubble on every corner turned. The revenue this area usually relishes in has depleted immensely since the storm.

Relief workers and government agencies have been working to rebuild this town, and the people of Biloxi are determined to “revive the renaissance” and are coming back strong. We are going to render our help to aid in this effort, not only by meeting their physical needs, but by bringing these people the message of hope. Igniting a flame of hope in their hearts through Jesus will not only impact them while we are there, but it will also give them faith to hold onto as they continue to persevere.

The team will be conducting a “Hope Festival” over two nights, similar to our Richmond Reach-Out. In preparation for this trip, we have received nothing but grace and favor. The city has been wide open to us, and so many people are excited about participating. The first night will be held at a local school with 1,000 FEMA trailers close by, filled with families who will be able to attend. The next day will be an all day event at John Henry Beck Park, located in East Biloxi. This area, stereotyped for poverty, crime, and drugs, is prime ground to offer hope. The field here measures about half a town block, so we are expecting a huge crowd, especially of young people. Solid Rock Youth will be doing dramas, raps, and giveaways. There will also be games, basketball, and so many blessings for the people.

The people of Biloxi may have been pressed hard by this hurricane that tried to strike them down, but they were not crushed nor destroyed. They are still blessed because God’s promise endures and His joy is their strength. We are going



to share the joy of God's promises with them, rebuilding lives and restoring hope.

On the heels of this trip, another team of soul-winners on a mission will be traveling overseas to Nairobi, Kenya in August for our annual crusade there. We are returning to the capitol of this African nation, after last year's incredibly successful trip with over half a million souls saved. The expectations for this crusade are high. We are believing God for even more salvations and healings, as this city is set ablaze by the power of God.

Nairobi is one of the largest and fastest growing cities in Africa. It is becoming a very modern city, but still holds true to its history. Tourists from around the world are attracted to its illustrious culture, drawn specifically to the safari parks and other




natural elements of beauty. The city itself touches nature, surrounded by Nairobi National Park. The people are unique with an energy that unites their differences, a characteristic genuine to them. Nairobi is full of excitement and life, and we are going to inundate this city with the true life found in Jesus Christ.

For five nights, the crusade will be held on one of the largest fields we have ever had, Mathare Field. This field has never been used before for something like this, and hundreds of thousands of people have great access to it. With such a huge crowd, we are investigating acquiring a new and stronger sound system, giant projectors, and more and brighter lights to make the activity on the platform visible to everyone. Local churches will join with us, already providing 100 workers to help us when we arrive. Local artists, Christ's Ambassadors and Rufftone, will fire up the crowd with great music that is sure to get everyone dancing for Jesus. After drawing in the crowd, Pastor Randy Gilbert will passionately deliver the Word of God, and then lead hundreds of thousands of people in the prayer of salvation. So many other healings and miracles will take place, completely changing every person who sets foot on that field, impacting a nation.

Kenya is a field white to harvest. For many years, we have ventured into this land with the unchanging Gospel of Jesus Christ, reaping a greater harvest with each trip. We are excited about the incredible things that God is going to do.

Our heart for missions echoes God's heart, to go into all the world with the Gospel, starting at home and journeying to the uttermost parts of the earth. It is more than just a face that stands on any field; it is a soul that is worth all that God had to give. Worth far more than the most precious of jewels, so much so that He laid down His life. We are postured to let every face who comes to these fields know what they are worth. We have greater expectations to have greater impact. Pray with us that God's love will saturate all of these people.





On the night of the Passover, God gave Moses specific instructions for the nation of Israel to follow in accordance to His Word. That night, in the midst of the plagues over Egypt, the Israelites were to sacrifice the Passover lamb without defect, unto the Lord. The blood of that lamb was applied to the door frames of their homes, where they ate the lamb. This was “the Lord’s Passover,” a day that is to be celebrated for generations to come.

The Bible tells us in Exodus chapter 12, *“For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the Lord throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance forever”* (Exodus 12:12-14).

When that final plague of death swept over Egypt, the people inside those doors that had the blood applied to them were protected. The blood was their covering. If the blood had not been applied, there was no protection. Those with the blood on their door were passed over and spared.

A lasting ordinance had been set between God and His people. It marked the beginning of the Hebrew calendar, which is to be observed as a special day.

“And He took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: This do in remembrance of me. Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you...For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end” (Luke 22:20-21, 37).

Jesus came to completely fulfill the covenant that God set in place starting that first Passover night. As His disciples prepared for them to eat the Passover, prophetic fulfillment continued to fall into place.

In Luke chapter 22, the Bible says, *“And He took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: This do in remembrance of me. Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you...For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end”* (Luke 22:20-21, 37).

Jesus took the cup, sharing it with His disciples. Representing the Blood that He was destined to shed for the remission of all man’s sins, they drank from it. They also broke the bread to eat in remembrance of Him, and as a sign of His broken body that would be beaten and wounded for our healing.

The remainder of the Passion events following the Passover would go on to fulfill the old testament, and set in place the new covenant for us to live in today. The most powerful thing is that Jesus saw each one of us, even when we were afar off, as He walked up the hill of Calvary to die for us. He endured the pain and torture

before the cross, so that He could say, "It is finished," with His last breath, as the weight of the world's sins was placed heavily upon His shoulders.

But the story does not end there! Praise God! Jesus conquered death, hell, and the grave to raise victorious, holding the keys to the Kingdom. The veil is now rent, and we have free access to the throne of grace through this new and living way. All we have to do is accept this free gift of salvation, believing on the great redemptive work of the Son of God.

Not only do we still celebrate the Passover today to remember the great plan of redemption, but we offer our best sacrifices unto God as well. Bringing our offerings before His feet, we call His divine protection and provision over our lives. God will restore anything the enemy has tried to steal from you and bless you beyond your imagination, as you sow a Passover offering.

The Passover offering is a powerful celebration that will move heaven on your behalf.

Last year, several testimonies came in about how God had blessed people financially after they sowed their Passover offering. One lady had believed God with her husband for three years for a change in his work schedule.

She wrote that, "On Passover night, after church I was praying. At midnight I remembered my Passover offering. I said, 'Lord, remember my husband's job.' The following morning my husband was approached by the department manager to change his schedule. When my husband gave me the news I said, 'Yes, my Passover offering. 



COMMEMORATIVE OF
POPE JOHN PAUL II



A LIFE OF HONOR

This past April, Pope John Paul II went home to be with the Lord after 84 years of a life that was committed to serving God. The story, of what could be said to be one of the greatest popes in history, started long ago, and is an incredible story of faith and love. His legacy promises to echo throughout the halls of history, and the impact he had on the Church will be felt for many years to come.

HUMBLE BEGINNINGS

Born as Karol Jozef Wojtyla on May 18, 1920 in Wadowice, Poland, this young boy who would become pope, faced much adversity while growing up. When he was just 8 years old, his mother died. Just a few years later, his only brother died, and some years after that his father also died. He lived under Nazi occupation, which prevented him from continuing in some of his educational opportunities.

Despite this opposition, Karol continued to seek out his spiritual walk, as well as his education and work life, including his passion for poetry and theatre. Once aware of his calling, he began his studies at seminary, and soon received his ordination into the priesthood. He obtained his doctorate in theology and began practicing his ministry. Karol had several other accomplishments as he advanced in the papal hierarchy.

A LEADER IN FAITH

On October 16, 1978 Cardinal Wojtyla began his Pontificate as Pope John Paul II. When he was announced to the public, he stated, *“I was afraid to receive this nomination, but I did it in the spirit of obedience to our Lord.”* (Source: CNN.com—*The Priesthood Years*)

Pope John Paul II could be seen as one of the most influential popes as he touched so many people through his travels, having the greatest audiences and meeting with the most leaders from all around the world. He also played an important part in the fall of

Communism, especially in his native Poland. His moral vision greatly impacted the Church.

Life as pope did not mean that the struggles he faced as Karol Wojtyla would suddenly disappear, or that Pope John Paul II would become invincible to the world. The strides he made in the Church and the stand he took for human rights were high standards for this time in world history. Once his values met opposition by an assassination attempt. He showed his character to be true when he visited the man in jail and forgave him.

THE LEGACY REMAINS

“This world is not capable of making man happy,” said Pope John Paul II. (Source: CNN.com—*The Papal Years*) He believed that a relationship with God was the most important pursuit in a person’s life, and was a prime example of this belief. It was through faith and prayer that he lived his life and made his decisions. He desired to continue to build the Church on its foundations, and not to waiver on what it stands for.

Pope John Paul II will always be known as a man of faith, prayer, and integrity. The stand he took for the Church and the strides he made for human rights are beyond measure. People all over the world will remember this man of God, and the impact he had on countless lives. The imprint that his life made on this world could never be erased.
